

We offer both academic or applied and university or college courses in Math and English to meet each student at their academic level. We also offer learning resource assistance to ensure that each student receives the extra help that is required in any particular area. Cooperative education courses are offered to each student in their grade 12 year to allow them an opportunity to gain experience and familiarity to various career options and settings.

Character Development: High school is about more than academics. It's about personal development and growth within a God-fearing environment. At Hope RCS we seek to cultivate this through required community volunteer hours, involvement on school committees to promote leadership qualities and engagement in mentorship with the elementary students and fellow classmates.

Part-time Enrollment: We work together with home schooled families who desire to enroll their children on a part-time basis in the secondary level.
